

10th Anniversary

This 2014 season marks the 10th anniversary of the Toronto Jr. Argonauts and promises to be one of their best yet. Looking to build on last year's success at the Junior Varsity and Varsity level, the Argos have shuffled their coaching staff in an effort to field one of the OFC's top teams.

Former St. Francis Xavier X-Man Carlo Onorati, Varsity head coach, boasts **two senior Toronto Metro Bowl** championships and a 2010 OFC championship at the JV level. Offensive Coordinator Jansen Shrubbs brings an all-star pedigree as a former **7th nationally ranked QB** for Queens and University of Toronto. Additionally, Chris Smith returns to Defensive Coordinator, bringing with him **CFL experience** from his time as a **Winnipeg Blue Bomber and Toronto Argonaut** to a staff full of CIS talent.

On the Jr. Varsity side, Carlo Trentadue, the first Jr. Argo head coach to have played for the club, hails from the University of Toronto. As does former OUA **Defensive Lineman of the Year**, JV Jr. Argos Defensive coordinator and current **U of T D-line coach** Joe Capiello. Derek Wiggan, **2014 top 15 CFL prospect** adds to an over qualified coaching staff that includes current and former players from Guelph, U of T, and Concordia universities.

Frank Trentadue, former St. FXU Second Team **All Canadian** brings his **6 Metro bowl titles** to his head coaching position at the Bantam level, as does Paul Forbes, the **most winningest coach in Ontario high school football history**. As this legendary duo turn their attention to developing the youngest players in the club, they are joined by a trio of long time Jr. Argos players-turned-coaches.

All in all, this year's Jr. Argonauts are in good hands and this campaign looks promising for the double blue.
